

English

To meet the objectives for this year group in English, the children will be able to choose a plot type we have covered so far this year, to create their own story. Our grammar will look at nouns and pronouns. For our non-fiction, we will write an informal letter from the perspective of an Anglo-Saxon. We will use the Spelling Book to continue to develop our spelling with regular spelling practice.

Mathematics

To meet the objectives for this year group in maths, we will continue to learn about fractions. We will recap some learning and key terminology from previous years. We will then move onto recognising, adding and subtracting decimal numbers. Our Real Life Maths focus will be on geometry- position and direction. We will continue to use Times Table Rockstars and songs to help us recap and practice our times tables daily, along with our arithmetic skills.

Science

Our science topic for this half term is teeth and the digestive system. We will learn about the different body parts that are involved with the digestive systems and their roles.

We will also learn about the different types of teeth in humans and animals. This will include the different names and various roles they have.

Anglo Saxons



History

In history, we will learn all about Anglo Saxons. We will look at time lines and how Anglo Saxons link with Romans; our previous history topic. We will identify the similarities and differences between England during Anglo Saxon times compared to now.

Religious Education

Our RE lessons this half term, will explore the question: For Christians when Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost? The children will learn the story of the Pentecost. We will look at how Christians believe the Holy Spirit helps them.

French

This half term, we will be describing family members and pets, with a focus on understanding the basic grammar and how to apply it.

Creativity: Art

For art this half term, we will focus on sculpture. We will make sculptures inspired by an Anglo Saxon village. We will start by looking at structures and exploring some sketches surrounding different structures. We will then learn how to join different materials and explore some of our own ideas.

Computing

We will be furthering our programming skills, focusing on repetition and loops. The children will design a wrapping paper with repeating patterns.

Music

In music we will be looking at the structure of music as well as the pitch that is used.

PE

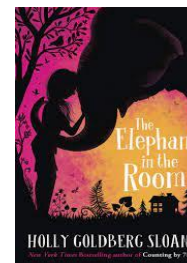
Our day for PE is **Friday**, so the children will need to come in wearing their PE kit this day.
