To meet the objectives for this year group in English, we will be exploring a wishing tale called 'A man in search of his luck'. The children will be then be able to invent their own versions using the learnt structure. Also, using our knowledge from Geography about Scandinavia, we will be writing a non-fiction piece. Mathematics

To meet the objectives for this year group in mathematics, the children will continue to develop their properties of shape including angles, position and direction, converting units, and volumes. As well as focussing on these key skills, we will continue to practice children's fluency with arithmetic skills including calculating with the four operations. Alongside this, we will continue to practice times tables daily.

Science

As scientists, the children will be focusing on scientific enquiries. They will be carrying out a number of experiments. Whilst doing so the children will have to think about their aims, predictions and methods. They will also be analysing their results and creating graphs to represent their data.
