Iman – means belief

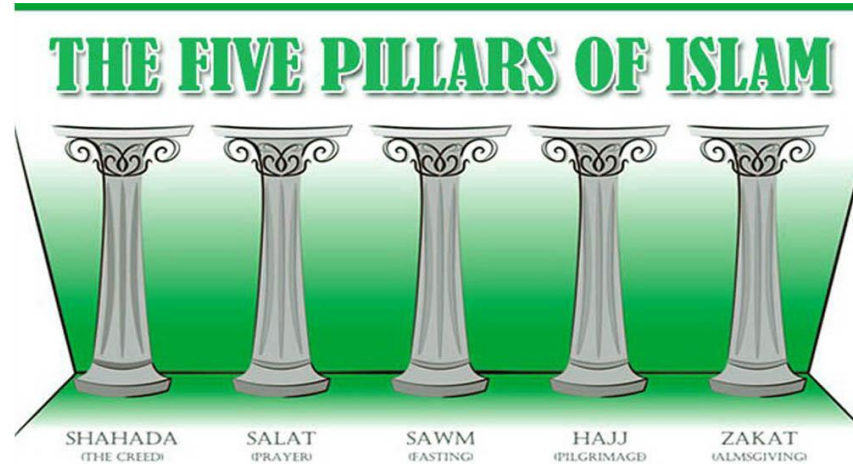
Shahadah – is one of the 5 Pillars. Declaring faith and belief.

Nativity – marks the birth of Jesus Christ.

Manger – a long trough that horses or cows feed from.

Advent – the season celebrated by Christians as a period of time counting down and waiting to celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ.



Advent wreath

The Advent wreath is a circular garland of evergreen branches representing eternity.

In the four weeks leading up to Christmas, one candle is lit each Sunday.

These candles represent a particular part of the preparation for the coming of Jesus.

The empty cross – Jesus did not stay on the cross

Purple – royalty – the Son of God who died on the Cross.

Gospel – good news

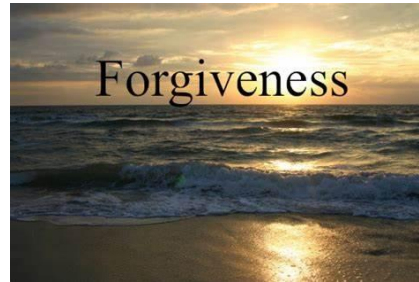
Forgiveness- to stop feeling bad against someone who has upset or hurt you.

- For Christians, this good news includes being loved by God, and being forgiven for bad things.
- Christians believe Jesus is a friend to the poor and friendless.
- Christians believe Jesus' teachings make people think hard about how to live and show them the right way.
