Dear Parents and Carers,

As you know Miss Mabin and Miss Stephenson are sadly leaving us at the end of this term. After a recent recruitment process I am pleased to announce that Miss Gaskin will be joining us as Year 2 teacher and Miss Naismith as Year 4 teacher from January. They are both looking forward to meeting the children and parents in due course and joining our team. We have also welcomed Mrs Luther as Teaching Assistant each morning in Y2. Mrs Vickers is now working each morning in Y6 and Mrs Smith is in the office each morning.

From January, we will be extending our school day to be in line with DfE requirements which are to be in place by September 2024 to ensure all children across the country are provided with 32.5 hours of school time education. This week, classes have all started their new topics and parent information has been sent out via class teachers along with a homework menu and knowledge organisers. Next week, we look forward to parent's evenings on Monday and Wednesday where teachers will be providing you with a summary progress sheet of your children's current attainment, effort and attendance.
