

Dobwalls Primary Remote Learning Plan – A Guide for Parents

In the event of any form of isolation caused by Coronavirus, the Government are expecting that parents will engage in home learning, as is the expectation that we make the provision available. Please do not worry, we will support you. Statutory Government Guidelines states we are required to plan work that will last for a minimum of three hours a day.

This plan will be applied in the following instances:

1. An individual is self-isolating because someone in their household is symptomatic or tests positive within the household;
2. A whole bubble is self-isolating because of a case of coronavirus in their class bubble;

Pupil needs to isolate because someone in their household is symptomatic or tests positive

- We will print a copy of the learning for the child to take away with them.
- We aim within 24 hours to provide a personalised learning pack for the time they will be off.
- We will provide children with 2-3 reading books at their level.
- The class teacher will make contact to catch up with your child twice during their 14-day isolation period

In addition, your child will be expected to:

- Read daily – books from home or **Oxford Owl Free Reading Books Online** access a range of super reading books to keep you reading whilst at home...

- Complete activities on TT Rockstars (KS2) or Mathletics
- Learn spellings as on the half term homework menu or as directed by the class teacher.

A whole bubble is isolating because of a case of coronavirus in their class bubble

- A work pack will be sent home with your child when the bubble closes, this will support learning for any part of the day left and for the first full day of isolation - this will cover basic skills work.
- If the bubble closes out of school hours, arrangements will be made so that you can collect the packs from school.
- On the first full day of closure you will receive an email from your child's class teacher sharing the arrangements for remote learning and expectations
- There will be short live sessions (no longer than 20 minutes) twice each day – these will be on MS Teams. We will also record short teaching activities so you can use them at a convenient time for you.
- Work will be uploaded to your child's class area on the Home Learning area of the school website.
- Mrs Pipe will record assemblies and post on the home learning area of the website. This will encourage the children to keep working, celebrate successes and promote a togetherness.

In addition, your child will be expected to:

- Read daily – books from home or **Oxford Owl Free Reading Books Online** access a range of super reading books to keep you reading whilst at home...

If your child's class teacher shows symptoms and becomes unwell during the whole bubble isolation, work will be uploaded to the school website but the 'live sessions' will be paused.

If your child is too ill to attend school then they are not be expected to engage in home learning. Please contact the office as you would a normal absence.
